FOR MEMBERS TURNING 59 ½ DURING THE TAX YEAR

Why did I receive two 1099R forms from ERSRI?

Due to the age at which you retired you potentially could be subject to a 10% pre-mature distribution tax penalty because you were receiving distributions prior to age 59 $\frac{1}{2}$. The first 1099R form will have a distribution code 2 in box #7 because you were receiving pension distributions prior to age 59 $\frac{1}{2}$. Code 2 allows pension recipients to receive distributions with exception to any penalties from the IRS for distributions prior to age 59 $\frac{1}{2}$.

The second 1099R form will have distribution code 7 in box #7. Code 7 allows pension recipients to receive normal distributions if they are at least age 59 $\frac{1}{2}$. Therefore, the combination of the two 1099R forms will be your total gross distribution for the tax year.

<u>Special Note:</u> The address shown on the 1099-R which you will receive will be the current address of record which the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island has on file when the forms are processed in January.
